A unusual feature of HGS is that its last two P.E. teachers were former pupils and Head Boys of the school, Leslie Tate and Derek Wilkinson. Without knowing it at the time (the 1940s) they were setting a fine example for pupils who were to follow in the next two decades. I suspect Mr. Hamilton knew what he was observing. Between them they had a remarkable succession of victories in the Victor Ludorum. They had 8 successive wins in 6 golden years. Looking at the Victrix Ludorum, Mary Griffiths, Amy Hepton and Annie Brammer were the stars of their time in HGS. The 1950s were dominated by one athlete, Brian Moore, with his 5 successive wins. At the 440 yards Brian was the one to beat in Yorkshire, if you could.
